- **Video Link:** In order to be eligible for the grand prize and specialty prizes, entries must also submit a link to a video that tells the story of the project from beginning to end. The video should not be longer than 5 minutes. To share your video with us you can either save it in a file sharing program such as Dropbox or Google Drive and then paste a link to your file in the box for this question or you can also upload your video to a service such as YouTube and then share the link. If you are sharing a link, please make sure that when you create the link you set the permissions to allow anyone with a link to be able to view and edit your files so that we can download them with your entry form.
- **Parental Release Form:** If you choose to include images featuring children you must include an official Carton 2 Garden parental release forms for each child. Failure to provide release forms will eliminate those photos from your entry. You can either save your release forms in a file sharing program such as Dropbox or Google Drive and then paste a link below or you can upload your files directly in the next question. If you don't have images of students in any of your photos or video or are uploading your release forms, please type 'N/A' in the box. If you are sharing a link, please make sure that when you create the link you set the permissions to allow anyone with a link to be able to view and edit your files so that we can download them with your entry form.
- **UPLOAD OPTION:** For your photos and parental release forms, if you don't have a link, you can upload directly into the entry form. There is a 1024KB limit on each photo file. Photos should be uploaded here in .jpg or .png format. Please upload your parental release forms as a .pdf file.
